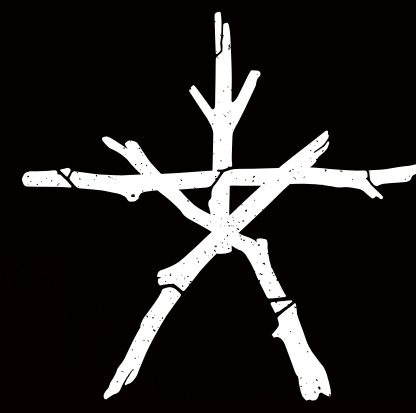

SESSION

Steady progress. The patient seems to open up more once some time has passed from the event. The drawing facilitates memory recollection. I was able to put together a rough timeline of events:

- the children leave the patient's house and enter the woods
- he finds a wounded animal in a snare
- he is drawn to a disturbance (an animal?)
- there is a man/wild beast?
- something happens (this is the repressed memory)
- the patient leaves the woods and is found by a truck driver

Will slowly build up towards the repressed memories, continuing using behavioral methods.

BACKGROUND SUMMARY & REASONS FOR REFERRAL

Patient brought in by parents due to extreme panic attacks, insomnia and sleep walking after a traumatic experience. I advise three therapeutic sessions per week. During a preliminary interview I was able to determine the following:

- the patient actively avoids recalling the event
- he experiences vivid nightmares since the event; possible coping mechanism
- he exhibits emotional numbness, irrational aggression and disassociation to the event
- overall, he is very nervous; possible undiagnosed anxiety neurosis.

Session began with patient expressing his wish to discontinue therapy. After an examination of his reasoning, we were able to continue. The patient then reported recurring night terrors. Repeated imagery of decrepit room corner, feelings of losing control, being unable to raise your eyes.

The patient refused to acknowledge what happened to his friend. Attempts at discussing the matter ended in an anxiety episode and we had to stop the session.

Note: The patient admits it's the pressure from his father that made him rethink therapy. When confronted on another occasion, the father expressed a desire to withdraw parental consent for his son's participation.

SESSION

The patient was able to reconcile his memories. Breakthrough happened when he acknowledged his friend's death. *guilt?*

The patient is still deeply motivated by the events.

- having trouble at school
- continues to report lack of control of his actions
- suffers from periodic panic attacks.

One example of this was recounted to me by the patient's mother.

During recess, a classmate of the patient started telling hunting stories of her father. The patient got deeply upset and then suddenly aggressive. He ended up pushing the classmate into the corner of the room and almost took her eye out.

Analysis of drawing notebook reveals a recurring theme. Tightly packed trees, numerous eyes of various size.

Patient in for monthly appointment in relation to his anxiety neurosis. Seems kept in check. Again, no discussion of the woods or his friend. Dissociative amnesia worsening?

... I admit this patient is beginning to concern me. Everyone seems to have moved on, but the fact that he does not talk about the woods at all is almost eerie. He has become interested in hiking, hunting. Was offered a scholarship out of state, but does not want to leave town. Something is keeping him here.

SESSION #76

The patient is in a terrible state. His speech pattern suggests he regressed to an earlier stage of development, perhaps pre-teen (that day?). He admits that the woods is calling to him. In his own words, it's a woman's voice.

I encourage the patient to return to the behavioral techniques we worked with over the year.

Last session with patient. He is leaving Burkittsville, in his own words he feels he is able to move on.

I am glad about this. Less glad about the how. He'll be enlisting in the military service, as his father, a colonel, convinced him to join. Worried about what effect this environment will have on a sensitive psyche. The stress and trauma of active duty might completely displace his childhood trauma with the woods. The same trauma that he already seems to have forgotten. However, I am afraid the woods will never leave him. No matter what occurs, it will remain beneath. The formative experience that made him who he is today.

DISTRICT OF MARYLAND

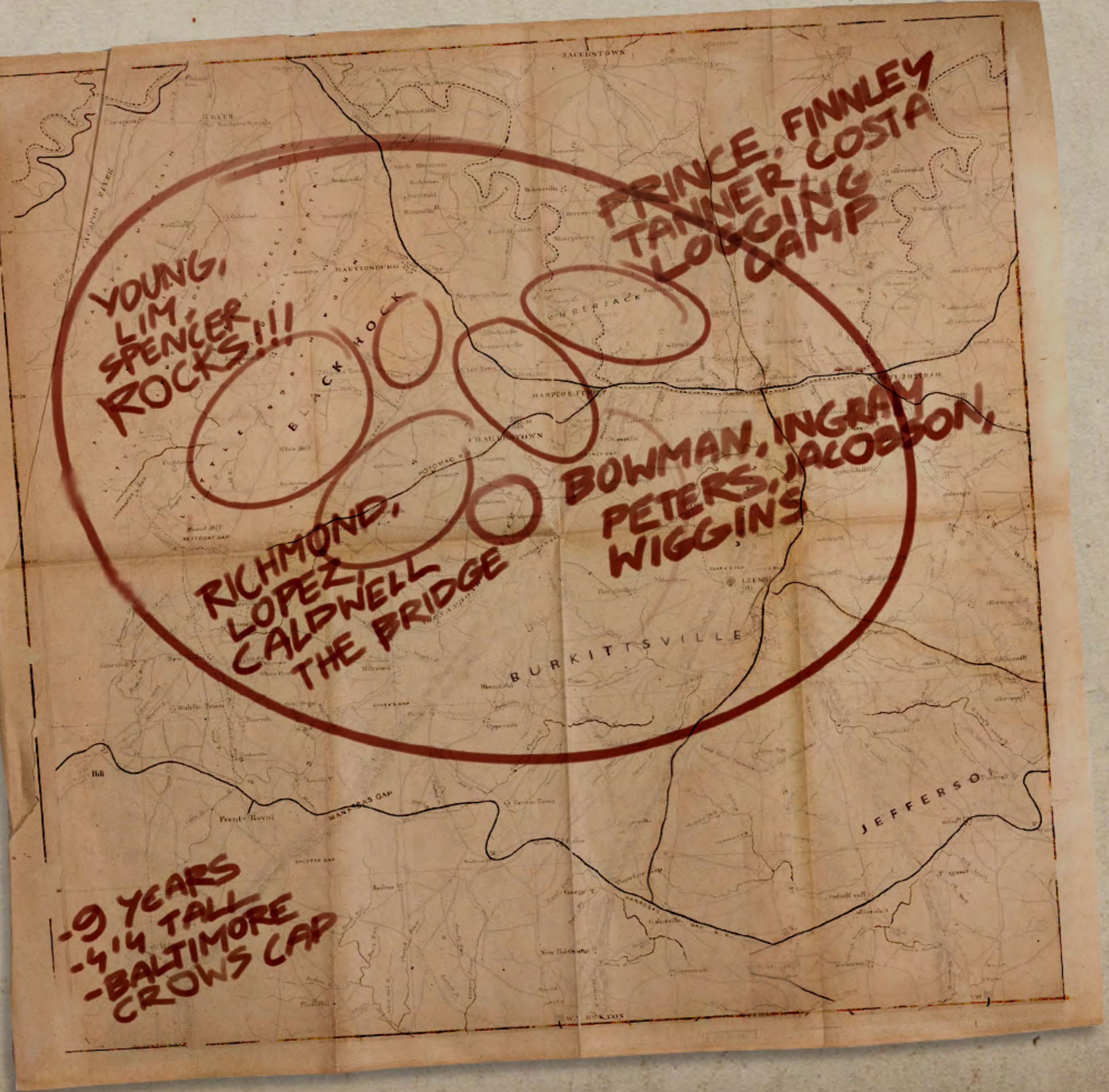

Fig. 1. Internal anatomy.

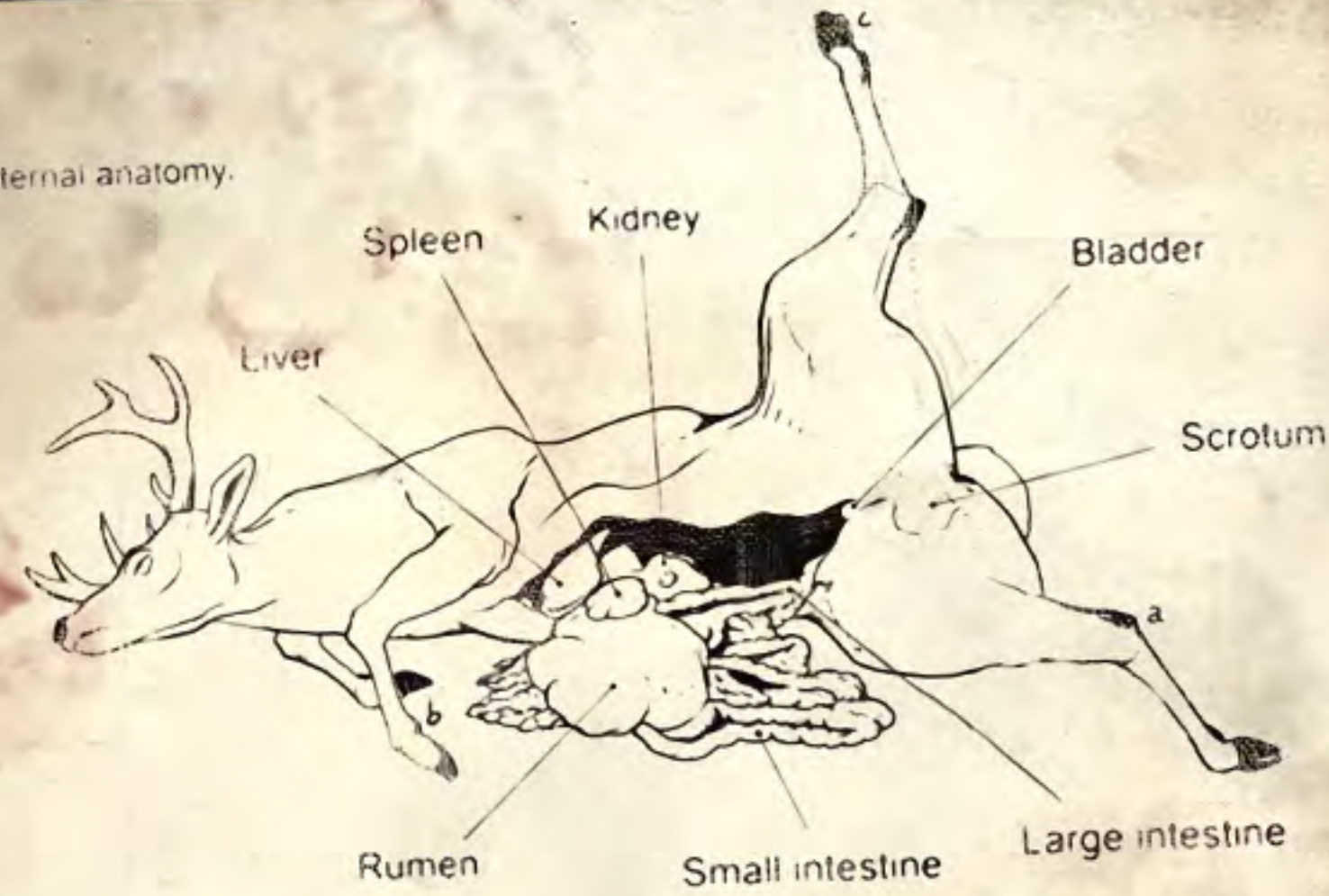


Fig. 2. Cutting the skin.

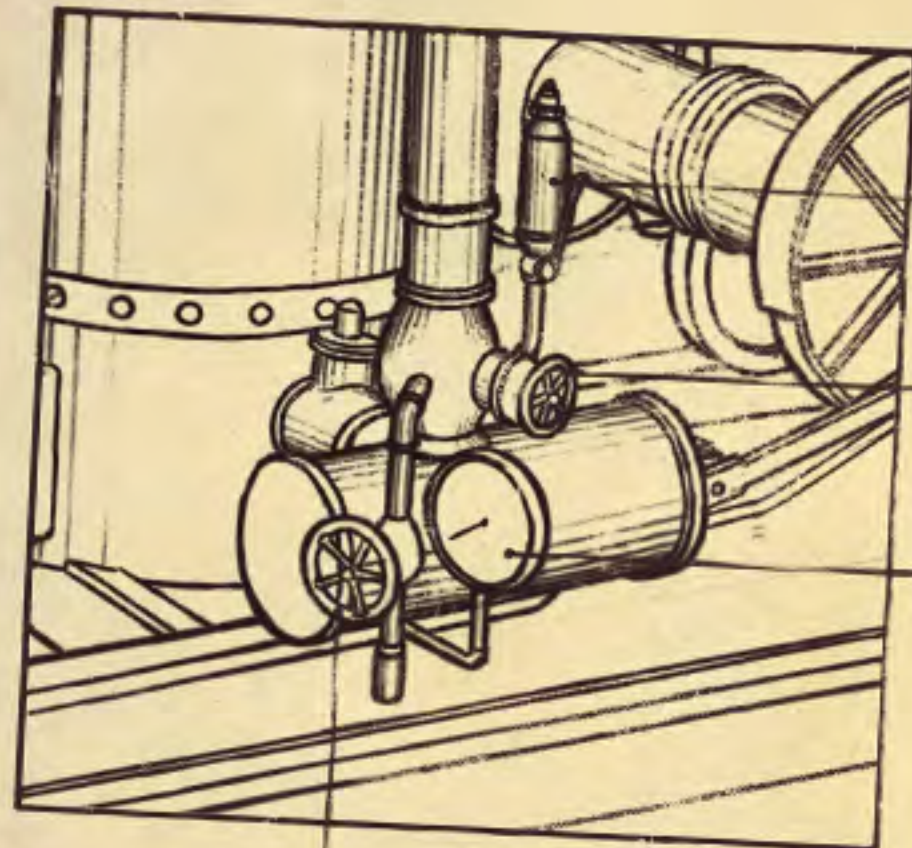


Fig. 3. Skinning setup.

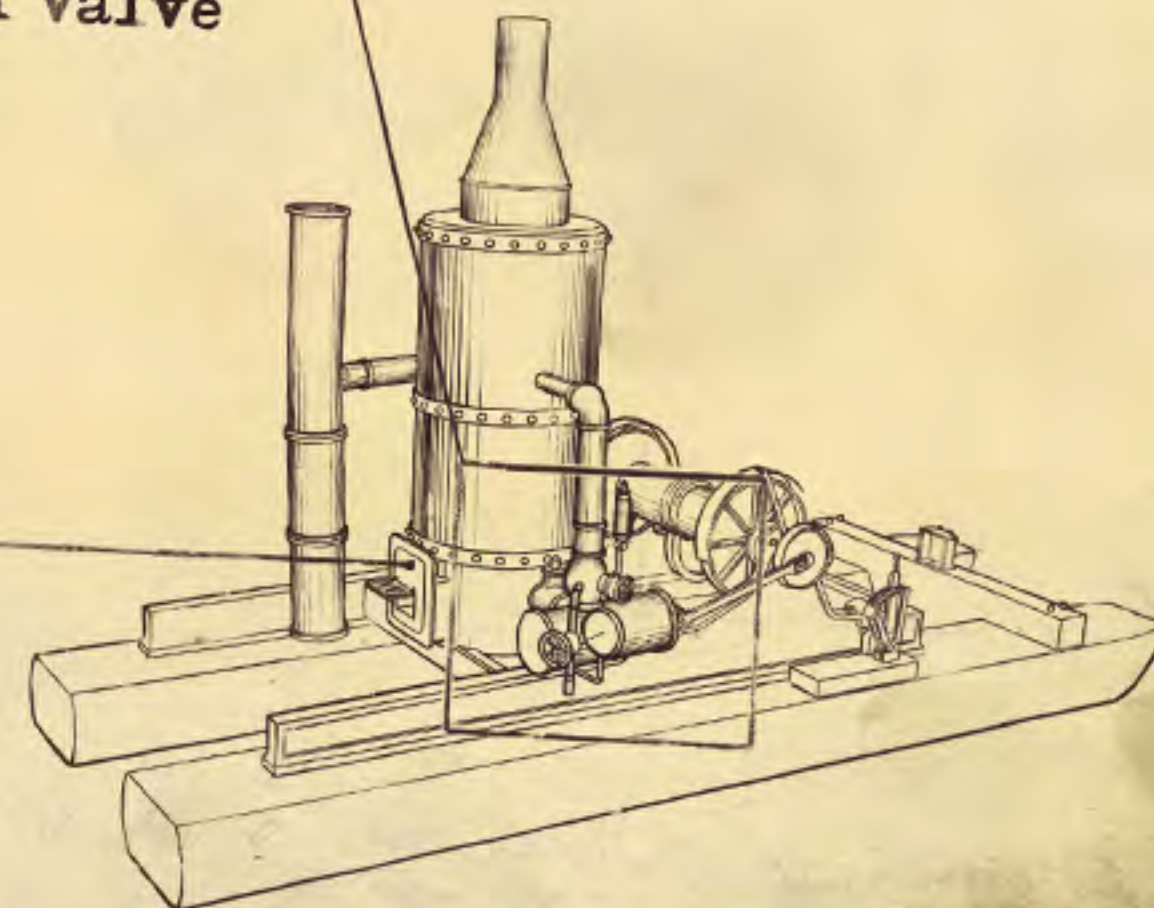
